## Introduction

In the end of year 2014, Legislative Yuan in Taiwan passed three Acts for Experimental Education, turning over a new leaf in the history of Taiwan's compulsory education. Experimental Education in Taiwan is a rich, complex concept which refers to non-traditional education or non-mainstream education, also absorbing the spirit of alternative education and homeschooling in other countries. Its original purpose is to encourage educational innovation, protect children's right to learn and receive education, provide parents with multiple educational methods and content to choose, and enhance the diverse development in education. As a role of promotion, Taiwan Experimental Education Center (abbr. TEEC) established by Ministry of Education in Taiwan has held the international conferences for past two years, in which introduce lots of innovative ideas abroad and share various experiences around the world. This year, we want to invite friends concerned for education to gather together again, deeply discussing about the outcome of experimental education: how to examine the effectiveness of alternative education different from regular system? How to ensure the high quality of an alternative education? How may today's experimental education become future generation's public education?

## Conference streams

This conference invites papers and sharing that explore and interrogate issues related to outcomes of experimental education. We welcome a diverse array of approaches and methodologies. Possible topics include but are not limited to the following:

# 1. Academic topics

All topics must be discussed related to the area of experimental education / alternative education.

The acceptance quotas of academic and practical papers will be distributed by the organizer according to the quality and quantity of submissions.

## Instructions

The official languages of the conference are English and Mandarin. Interested scholars and practitioners are invited to submit a 400-800 words extended abstract including keywords to <u>icee@teec.nccu.edu.tw</u> and an online application form (<u>https://reurl.cc/zXNz0</u>) before 30th August, 2019 (Friday). Electronic acknowledgements of submission will be sent to all submitters on receipt of the abstract.

- 1. Academic abstracts must include <u>research motivation</u>, <u>purpose and background</u>, <u>methodologies and approaches</u>, <u>initial research finding or implications</u>, and <u>outline of the paper</u>.
- 2. Practical abstracts must include <u>motivation</u>, <u>empirical findings</u>, <u>outline of sharing</u>, and <u>reference resources</u>.

#### Presentation

There are two ways of presentation in the conference: **oral presentation** and **posters**. Submitters can inform us of your preference in advance. We will announce the final results in the abstracts acceptance notification. Those selected to participate in conference will be notified on 12, September, 2019 (Thursday) and will be required to submit full papers and a brief CV (including name, e-mail address, institutional affiliation, and publication list) before 15, November, 2019 (Friday).

#### Guidelines for academic manuscript

1. Manuscripts need to be submitted in A4 size .doc (MSWord) or .docx (MSWord 2007) format only.

2. Full text for manuscript written in English is limited to 8000 words (12 point, Times New Roman) in APA or MLA format.

3. Manuscripts has not been published before and is not currently being considered for publication elsewhere.

4. Manuscripts accepted in this conference will be published after revised.
